Tony Robinson pieces together common threads regarding our wardrobe, gender expectations, and the roles we play, stitching them to historical and biblical underpinnings of both gender identity and worship of God.

Tony Robinson then peels this fabric back to expose the naked truth of the things we hide behind in life, death, and the afterlife, revealing a forgotten significance and worldview that is more than skin deep.

The last chapter contains review questions for each chapter. Many of the questions include new material related to the chapter they are addressing. This final chapter lends itself to classrooms, group discussion, or private meditation that can help the reader think through the book's material for application within daily life.

Why is the last chapter written like this?

Because why you believe something and whether you translate your belief into consistent practices are more important than simply saying that you believe it.

Tony Robinson was a self-supporting church planter, and served struggling churches for years as a bi-vocational preacher. He has lived from New York to Hawaii, but his return in 2020 to full-time ministry began in Alabama.

Tony Robinson received a congressional appointment to a U.S. military academy and later served in war as a commissioned officer. He was also a federal law enforcement officer (A video dramatizing U.S. Postal Inspector Tony Robinson's response to a nationally covered catastrophe is a ten-year museum display from 2014 until June, 2024, at the Smithsonian Institution, Washington, D.C).

Robinson has been quoted by nationally recognized media outlets, such as USA Today, and was featured on the Trinity Broadcasting Network. He was also the cohost of a television series and the host of a Christian radio program.

He has degrees in Pastoral Theology and Church Ministries with a concentration in educational ministries. He also has graduate work in geology and taught high school Earth Science. Tony has additional undergraduate studies in the field of Electronic Engineering Technology.

Besides being a Notary Public, he holds certification in SCUBA, SCBA, and aircraft piloting. He worked under the late Sam Walton as a store manager. Tony also served for several years as the Treasurer and member of the Board of Directors of a Coast Guard Employees Credit Union.

Robinson has also been an associate producer of Christian comedy and science fiction movies.

Tony Robinson, his nine children, and his wife, a Pensacola Christian College graduate and former faculty member, assist in pro-life outreaches.

In 2007, he was among 30 leaders from around the nation called to a pro-life summit to be part of the launching of American Right To Life, based in Colorado.

This event signaled the ascension of the personhood wing of the pro-life movement that helped give rise to abortion abolitionists. American Right to Life Action and its partners have since helped bring the personhood of pre-born children back into the center stage of mainstream politics.

Tony and his family are also VIP Boarding Pass charter members of The Ark Encounter, Williamstown, Kentucky.


